Vendor Rules & Guidelines

- Vendors will provide their own table, chairs, and covers, if needed.
- There is NO CAMPING on festival grounds or on the streets. See overnight accommodation information below.
- NO Parking within closed areas of festival grounds!! You will be allowed to park near the festival fence to unload ONLY.
- Vendors will provide their own table, chairs, and tent if required.
- All booths MUST be set up by 4:00 p.m. either on Thursday June 11th or 4:00 p.m. Friday June 12th
 - **Gate will be locked at 4:00 p.m.** Thursday and Friday.
 - 1 overnight security guard will be on the grounds Thursday & Friday 12am - 7am; however The Louisiana Corn Festival is NOT responsible for Lost, Stolen, or Damaged merchandise.
 - Gate will NOT be unlocked until midnight!! If you choose to leave with your merchandise on Saturday Night before midnight, you must carry your items to your vehicle; you will NOT be allowed to pull your vehicle inside the gate onto festival grounds.
- Applications are received on a first come basis, as per the stamped post date, if full balance is not paid by May 30th, you will move to end of the line. You are welcome to submit vendor fees in monthly payments to hold your spot until your balance is paid in full.
- No sirens, flashing lights, or loud music will be permitted in the booths.
- We do NOT give refunds for unsuitable weather.
- Make sure to list all items being sold, as we do not allow duplicates.
- No Vendors are allowed to sell Coke Products, Cheeseburgers, and Fried Dough of any kind. The Louisiana Corn Festival has maintained a contract with 2 other vendors for 30 years who we allow to sell these products
- All food items MUST be approved by the **food vendor chairman, Joey Frank (318) 305-0678**
- Copy of insurance to accompany application.
- You will be provided two bracelets allowing you on to the festival grounds with no gate charges. ONLY 2 will be given, NO EXCEPTIONS. Gate Fee is \$3 for 21 and up & \$1 for Under 21 for any additional bracelets needed.
- We reserve the right to stop taking applications prior to the deadline if the area has been filled. This is the only time you will received a refund.
- We reserve the right to require any vendor who does not comply with festival rules to leave and no future applications will be accepted and NO Refund will be given.
